Entry Period

Friday, September 18 – Wednesday, October 14, 2020 (both dates inclusive)

Entry/theme

Tanka poem expressing a present-day student's view, daily life, everyday feelings and sentiments, etc.

Eligible contestants

Undergraduate and graduate students (must be formally registered in university as full-time students)

Rules

Entries must be unpublished original *tanka* poems written by contestants. Entries that are simultaneously submitted to other *tanka* contests or are extremely similar to already published works will be disqualified.

How to enter the Contest

Write your poem and the required information in the attached application form, convert the file into a PDF, and send it to the address below.

* Each contestant may enter an unlimited number of *tanka* poems but must submit one form per poem. Two or more poems by the same contestant cannot be selected as winning works.
