

CALL FOR APPLICANTS SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED TO FOREIGN STUDENTS TO ATTEND AN 1 WEEK CULTURAL EXPERIENCE PROGRAMME IN INDIA (2nd Programme 2018-2019)

Sharda University, Delhi NCR, India, offers fifty (50) scholarships to foreign students from countries worldwide in order to attend its 2nd Cultural Experience Programme from October 22, 2018 to October 28, 2018.

PROGRAMME CONTENT:

- Attend CHORUS 2018, the largest multi-cultural festival in the north of India.
 - $\circ~$ A 3 day cultural student fest organized by the students
 - Dance, music, fashion, and chess competitions
 - Sculpture, painting, design, and photography exhibitions

- 3 workshops of 3 hours duration each on Indian art, society, culture, dance, & yoga (100% tuition free)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

- 1. Be nationals of any country except India.
- 2. Be undergraduate of postgraduate students in any one of these fields: Business Studies, Engineering, Law, Arts and Languages, Basic Sciences, Medicine, Dentistry, Nursing, Art, Design, and Media, Health Sciences, Music, Languages, Architecture, Social Sciences, Education, Liberal Arts.
- 3. Have a Grade Point Average of at least 7 and above (on 10 point scale) or GPA: 3.00 and above (on 4.00 point scale) or Merit, or Grade B and above.
- 4. Have knowledge of English.
- 5. Hold a valid passport.

To apply applicants must submit the following:

- 1. CV (should include your name, age, nationality, address, phone number, email address, and a recent photograph)
- 2. One recommendation letter from a professors or teacher who is familiar with the applicant's work.
- 3. One essay of no more than 1200 words (4 pages, double space) discussing the reasons why they wish to travel to India and in what ways India will benefit them to their careers (The essay must be written in the English language)
- 4. An official letter or transcript from their university certifying course of study at present, year of study, and Grade Point Average (GPA).



CV's, essay, transcripts, and letters of recommendation must be submitted electronically to studyabroad@sharda.ac.in.

All application forms and other documentation must be written or translated in English. Incomplete, inaccurate, or illegible application files will not be taken into consideration.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

The application deadline is: September 30, 2018

DURATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The duration of the scholarship is 1 week and is offered only for the 2nd Cultural Experience Programme of Sharda University. The programme will start on October 22, 2018 and will end on October 28, 2018. After completion of the programme Sharda University will provide students with a Certificate of Attendance.
